### WHAT IS AN ALL-GENDERS WASHROOM?

An All-Genders Washroom is a washroom that anyone can use regardless of their gender.

## WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO HAVE ALL-GENDERS WASHROOMS ON CAMPUS?

McMaster University is made up of people from different backgrounds, experiences and gender identities. Being able to access safe and accessible washrooms is a human right; however, for campus members who identify as transgender, gender non-binary, two-spirit or who do not conform to strict gender expectations, washrooms are often unsafe places where they may be subjected to verbal and physical harassment.

All-Genders Washrooms offer an alternative that is a safer and more private option for campus members to use the toilet or to freshen up.

### WHAT'S WRONG WITH JUST HAVING MEN'S/WOMEN'S WASHROOMS?

Some people may experience difficulties or feel unsafe in men's/women's washrooms for many different reasons. They may be harassed or told they are using the "wrong" washroom because they don't conform to certain expectations about how someone should look or dress. All-Genders Washrooms are more accessible to parents or support persons/caregivers for persons of another gender.

### I'M A MAN/WOMAN. MAY I USE THEM?

Yes, anyone regardless of their gender identity may use an All-Genders Washroom.

# WHY ARE THERE SIGNS INSIDE SOME OF THE MEN'S/WOMEN'S WASHROOMS ON CAMPUS?

You may see signage in various washrooms on campus to indicate that the washroom is an inclusive space and that McMaster University respects everyone's right to choose the washroom that is appropriate for them. The signage also reminds us **that it is not possible to identify someone's gender from their appearance**.

# I'M TRANSGENDER, GENDER NON-BINARY OR TWO-SPIRIT. WHAT OTHER THINGS SHOULD I KNOW WHEN NAVIGATING MCMASTER SERVICES?

In addition to the All-Genders Washrooms, the Equity and Inclusion Office has introduced an online resource for transgender, gender non-binary and two-spirit students, staff and faculty that provides information on how to navigate various issues on campus; for instance, where to go for information about your rights, what to do if someone refuses to use your correct name or pronoun, etc. For more information, please visit equity.mcmaster.ca/trans-inclusion.
